Description

The Region 3 Senior Membership Elevation Committee invites all IEEE members who are eligible for senior membership to join a region-wide senior member roundup. If you are an IEEE member in good standing with more than 10 years of professional experience or academic accomplishments, you may be eligible for IEEE senior membership. Please see https://www.ieee.org/membership/senior/ for details on the senior membership rank.

The Region 3 Senior Member Roundup provides nominations and reference providers to qualified IEEE members who are ready for elevation to the rank of Senior Member. To get started, please contact the Region 3 senior member coordinator, Andrew Seely, andrew.seely@ieee.org today. We'll need your current resume in the Region 3 Senior Member Template format, member number, IEEE section, and email address. This coordination must be accomplished one week in advance of the roundup.

We will coordinate your nomination and assign you with references who will conduct a live 30 minute get-to-know-you interview on a Zoom call, and then complete your full senior member nomination package. You do not need to fill out your own nomination for this process.

Come meet dozens of other senior members from around the region and enjoy an easy and fun senior member elevation process. Members from all R3 sections are welcome to participate!

Please note: Advance registration is required, and you must coordinate with Andy to get a confirmed slot in the roundup. You will need to send your name, section, email, member number, and a senior members template formatted resume. Personalized meeting invitations will be sent independent of vtools.

IEEE R3 Senior Member Roundup - What to Expect

Hello Senior Member Roundup volunteers, supporters, and senior member candidates!

We'll hold our first roundup of the year this Saturday the 4th, kicking off at 1200 ET. We will have almost 100 IEEE members in this meeting, where we will complete nominations for 47 senior member candidates.

All roundup meetings are held in the same Zoom room: https://umgc-edu.zoom.us/my/andrew.seely

Join at noon for the orientation and communications check. During this half hour period we help make sure that everyone is able to connect, cameras and microphones are working, and folks know how to navigate the environment. Hermann Amaya (Florida West Coast Section) will talk about the history of the roundup process. Mario Guerrero (Broward Section) will demonstrate the Senior Member Workspace in the IEEE Collabratec environment. Khalid Alosaylan (FWCS student branch) will talk about how to get technical help during the session. There will be time for questions. While the orientation is not required, it is highly encouraged to join and be in position early.

Each candidate should have received a calendar invitation for the orientation and for a group meeting. There are three groups for this roundup. Group 1 is 1230 to 1300. Group 2 is 1300 to 1330. And group 3 is 1330 to 1400. We will be completely done a little after 1400. Please be sure to be online in the Zoom five minutes early if you don't attend the orientation.

As each group starts, I will move each candidate and the two assigned reference providers into a private breakout room. You will see in your Zoom a request that you are being invited to a breakout room, which you should accept. Please note that it takes a few minutes for me to get everyone assigned and moved, so please be patient. After a half hour we will close all the private rooms and everyone will return to the main group. I will send a broadcast message with a five minute warning before we close the rooms. At the end of a group session, candidates are free to go, and reference providers without a follow-on interview are also free to go. If references and candidates need to continue their conversation, you are welcome to connect independently outside of the session.

For candidates: These interviews are really just casual chats about your experiences. Reference providers will ask you questions and get you talking and they'll take notes for the endorsements

they write to complete your nomination package. This should be a fun, easy, and low-stress experience for you. After this event, you don't have anything to do but wait for the Admissions and Advancement panel to meet on 18 February to make final decisions about promotions. You should have an announcement on that decision a week later. If you receive a denial or deferral message, please share that with me promptly. If you are successfully promoted and you would like to return to the roundup as a reference provider, please contact Kristina Chapman kac6g@virginia.edu and you'll be added to the roster. If you are unable to attend the roundup, please let me know right away!

For reference providers: Thank you for supporting this effort and giving us a little bit of your weekend! The schedule is finalized. Most reference providers have three candidates, some have two or one. All candidate resumes have been made available in advance, please let me know promptly if you do not have access. Please note, you will not get a notice from the IEEE system that you have a reference to write until the nominator completes the nomination. That's OK, we're not expecting nominations to be completed until Saturday morning. If you have the official system request to complete a reference, please do NOT do so until you have met with the candidate. You are highly encouraged to complete the reference during the interview session. If you are not able to do so, please complete it as soon as possible. An incomplete reference will prevent a candidate from being considered for promotion until the next cycle in April. If you are unable to attend or complete the reference, please let me know immediately.

For nominators: The schedule is complete and all assignments for candidates and reference providers have been provided. Please let me know promptly if you do not have what you need. You should also have the draft "how to nominate" guide, which I will also appreciate any comments or suggestions as we finalize it. Please try to get all nominations completed by Saturday morning. As you complete each nomination assigned to you, please update the status column in the tracker. Reminder that nominators do NOT need to attend the roundup (but you're welcome to!). Let me know if you have any problems or challenges to solve!

The next senior member roundup will be 25 March, following the same recipe. Volunteers will get a call for participation in the next couple weeks.
